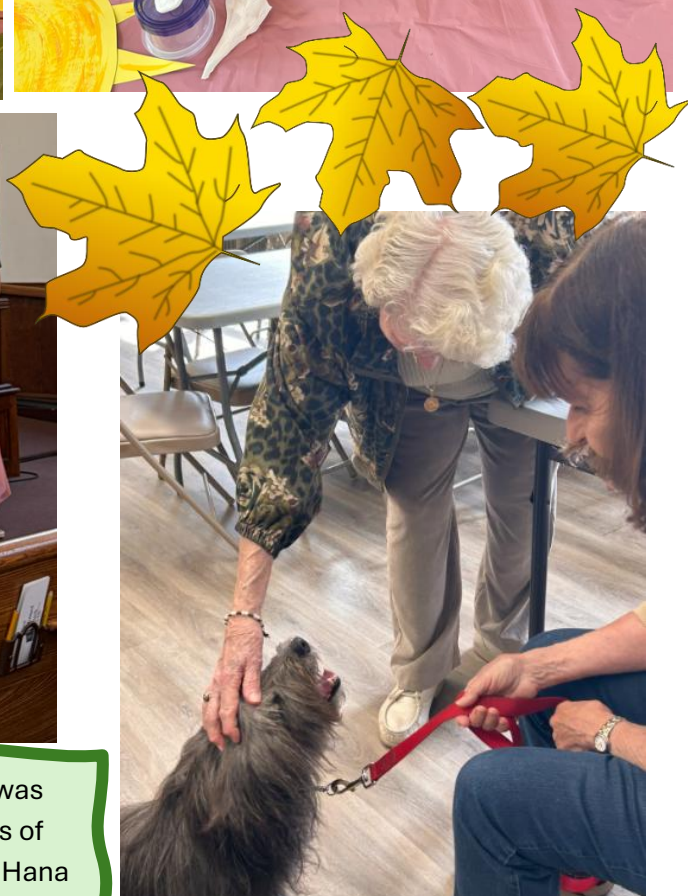


Meredith, Juan, and Sullie Soto recently moved into their new house—which was built on the foundation of their old house! At left, a beautiful home for a sweet family.
